We have been focussing on life-cycles, looking at the plants and creatures in our garden. The children are very good at talking about how frogs and butterflies grow and change from eggs to adults. The children enjoy using subject specific language such as 'chrysalis' and 'metamorphosis'.

In the classroom we had a delivery of very tiny caterpillars. We carefully transferred these to special pots with food for them to eat. We have been watching the caterpillars grow, they more than doubled in size over the weekend.

We study them each day and talk about the changes we have observed. Some are beginning to form a chrysalis. We can't wait to see the beautiful butterflies emerge after their transformation.
